For 40 years, Care For the Homeless has fought homelessness in New York City by providing high-quality and client-centered health care, shelter, and supportive services to individuals and families — and by advocating for policies to ameliorate, prevent, and end homelessness.

Founded in 1985 as a pilot program funded through grants from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and The Pew Charitable Trusts, Care For the Homeless was one of the first national Health Care for the Homeless projects in the U.S. From humble beginnings, with just three mobile teams and a few exam rooms, CFH has grown into a citywide leader in this unique type of integrated care.
